Description

An exchange event has been organized in GUbbio from 19th to 22nd of April. Representatives from the twin towns of Gubbio took part in the event.

The products presented at the meeting were of two different types: Thann, Huntingdon, Godmanchester and Gubbio focused on the origins and the history of their twinnings, while, for Wertheim and Szentendre, young people highlighted the new needs, the future perspectives and the opportunities offered by twinnings, and this provided cues for a wide and interesting debate, in which participants of different ages and positions intervened.

The workshops of visual arts, drama and dance held in the afternoon of April 20th gave an invaluable contribution to the success of the meeting, thanks to a variety of performances and exhibits. Particularly relevant was the group discussion, which produced a number of ideas and proposals to find new strategies to revive and re-invent twinning relationships, where young people should play a leading role, in line with the objectives of the project.

The meeting of mayors and institutional representatives turned out to be another highlight of the event, from which emerged a common intention to work together and exchange information about practical issues of the town administrations, such as green transition, work and training, welfare, peace and migrants.

The celebrations of the 65th anniversary of the twinning between Gubbio and Thann and the 10th between Gubbio and Huntingdon and Godmanchester were moving moments with memories of their origins (St Ubaldo's relic) and of people who promoted them (Malcolm Lyons).

The evening meals in the Ceri taverns offered the participants a chance to be immersed in the true spitit of twinning by an enjoyable contact with the community of Gubbio.

We think the event had great success, thanks to the active and productive response of the partners to the requests of the project leaders: survey on the awareness of the existence of town partnerships by the communities, realization of a "product" on the history and significance of twinnings in each town, contribution to debate on the future of twinnings and of Europe.

With reference to the first point, a common element characterising the results of the survey was the acknowledgement of the importance of twinnings and the will to continue with exchanges, both virtual and in presence; all confirmed the need of using social media and websites for the exchange of information, but individual and group visits are crucial for the vitality of a twinning.

From all the activities and contributions given during the event, including those of politicians and experts, we can draw the following conclusions and underline the following needs:

- Consolidation of a sense of belonging to Europe and its founding values
- Future exchanges based on the discussion of practical issues
- Greater involvement of schools, youth groups and associations to continue or create exchanges
- Use of social media, websites and platforms for the exchange of information
- Continuous contacts among institutions
- Vital necessity of personal contacts, through visits, exchanges, cultural initiatives


